Summary of the Final Evaluation.

Final evaluation

- Kino Kiseki should be used only after a previous test has shown that the plaster is tolerated.
- This test can be executed with different testing methods, especially suitable is the testing method Prognos®.
- The tolerability test showed a positive result in 4 of 5 test persons and a negative result in one test person.
- The effect of the application of Kino Kiseki-Plaster in persons, which tested negative in the tolerability test, was not tested.
- **The effect of the Kino Kiseki-Plaster as extracting or rather detoxification agent could be confirmed in all cases.**
- Patients react with various intensity, depending on the sensibility of the person and depending on the type of toxin.
- Even in cases of intensive reaction to detoxification all test persons experienced a general feeling of well being.
- The use of Kino Kiseki-Plaster for more than a week (six days according to package size) was found to be a too short period: from the test results it can be concluded that the detoxification process is generally not completed after six days.
- **The detoxification or rather extraction process is periodic:** On the basis of the variation of the integral level of vital energy and the level of inner order, intensive and mild extraction phases can be inferred.
- Such reaction phases in the Prognos test results are alternating in a daily to three daily rhythms.
- **The sequence of test results points to a rhythmic process of detoxification in the sense of a swinging bio cybernetic system.**
- **All patients tolerated the plasters well or very well.**
- **Patients showed great consent to this method of extraction or rather detoxification.**

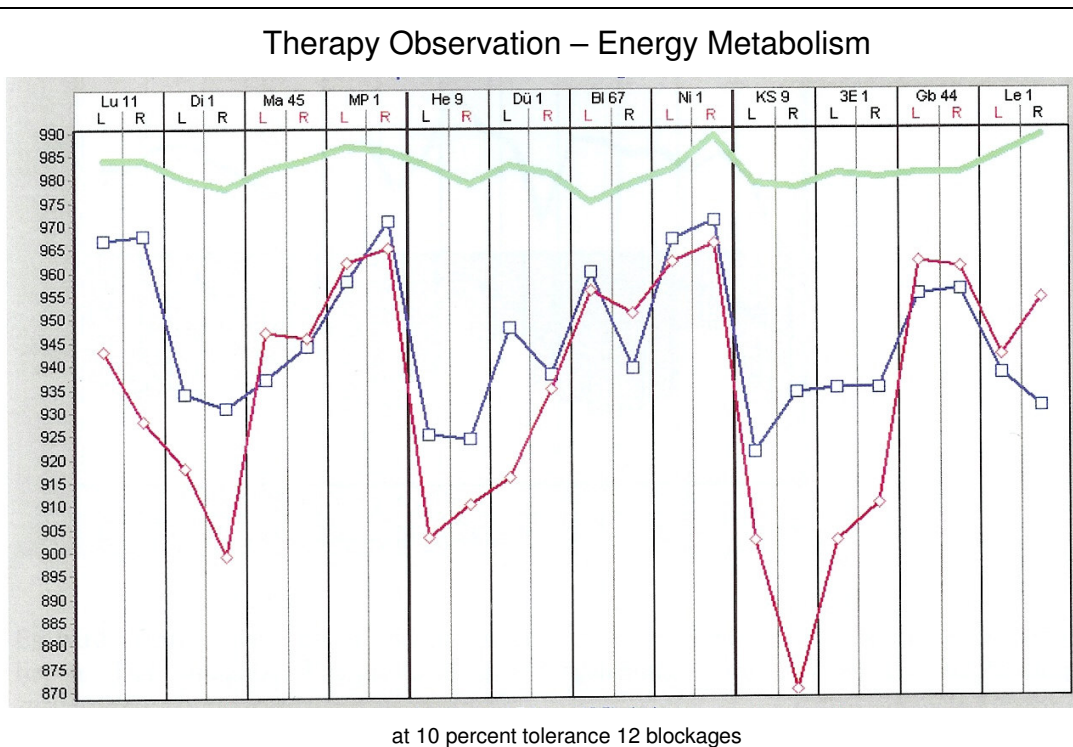
- **The most effective result is reached when Kino Kiseki-Plaster is used together with other complementary methods for excretion or detoxification.**
- Detailed evaluation of test results show interesting particulars with regards to the type of extraction induced.
- The detailed analysis of the test results shows in every test person identically that very typical ways for excretion are initiated with the use of Kino Kiseki-Plaster.
- To illustrate this, following is a test example of test person no. 3.
- The graph shows the test results arrived at by the expert system Prognos® of test person M.E. as received on day three after the beginning of detoxification with Kino Kiseki-Plaster:

Test results on 3rd day of detoxification of test person M.E.

(As generalizing example)

- Upper green blue graph = Norm graph
- Blue graph = reference graph before first application
- Red graph = test graph on 3rd day of application



- This graph shows the energy metabolism on day 3 after application of Kino Kiseki-Plaster and stands as an example for the typical graph, which was repeatedly measured in all test persons.

- The red graph representing this day, falls within the area of “upper meridians” clearly under the reference curve of the previous day, which means a clear decrease of energy compared to the decrease of energy compared to the previous day and it can be concluded that the excretion process was activated again.
- The decrease of energy is seen especially clear and exemplary in the function areas Lu/Di; He/Dü; and Ks/3E – all “upper meridians”, which are used in this special excretion process, which is activated by the Kino Kiseki-Plaster.
- Contrary to this, no energy loss is shown in all “lower – meridians” which belong to the very typical and “normal” excretion organs, like Bl/Ni; Gb/Le but also Ma/Mp.
- Through this result, which was analogically found in all test persons, one draws the conclusion that through the Kino Kiseki-Plaster the organism opens **an additional channel for excretion** and **at the same time relieves strain on the** normal excretory organs like bladder/kidney and gall bladder/liver.
- Further it is to be mentioned that these excretion processes are realized, though the organism is not within the area of energetic norm (green graph) and shows an integral lack of energy of 49%.
- These results which have been found in other test persons are of fundamental importance **because:**
 1. in patients stressed by concentration of heavy metal or other toxins, often a clearly marked general lack of energy is seen. In spite of this, an energy consuming detoxification becomes necessary, though due to the existing lack of energy, the physiological extraction channels meant primarily for this process, are blocked.
 2. in such patients, as well as in elderly people, the function of liver and kidneys is often reduced so that this extraction channel is already restricted in itself.
 3. in very massive toxic stress on the excretory organs (function radius), liver and kidney (inclusive of function radius gall bladder and bladder) are overstrained and additional channels for excretion are urgently needed.
 4. through Kino Kiseki-Plaster an extra extraction channel through the soles can be activated,
 5. this is a physiological method, which means natural detoxification (extraction through the skin as extra means and emergency reaction of the body), which can be activated through the Kino Kiseki-Plaster in a very special way.
 6. according to the holistic soles – reflex zones, it is obviously a general stimulation of all functions spheres of the organism towards detoxification, which further more, is channeled through the soles (no global skin reaction!).
 7. It is a relatively gentle detoxification method, which relieves the “classical” excretory organs.

- With the criteria mentioned from no. 1 to 7, the possibilities for the use of Kino Kiseki-Plaster increase by an important area: **as additional therapeutic agent in the medical treatment of intoxication!**
- **It is of special importance that this method of detoxification can still be chosen and still works in cases where already a substantial lack of vital energy in the organism exists**, if the classical ways for excretion are blocked, overstressed or their function is impaired.
- The use of Kino Kiseki-Plaster is indicated as additional detoxification method even in cases of severe intoxication or if the normal detoxification channels have to be supported or relieved for various reasons.
- **With this Kino Kiseki-Plasters prove to be a further valuable therapeutic remedy in the hands of a therapist that opens new therapeutic possibilities!**
- The results show that this method of detoxification can be used with great effectiveness, especially in cases of stress in the area of the head (stress through concentration of heavy metal, problems in the tooth and jaw area.)
- **A distinct improvement of the clinical condition as a result of the application of the Kino Kiseki-Plaster was found in all patients.**
